

Exclusive competences of the Union

Competition rules necessary for the functioning of the internal market;

Customs Union;

Common comercial policy;

Monetary policy for Member States whose currency is the euro;

Conservation of marine biological resources, under the common fisheries policy.

Is there a common element or factor among them ?

Single / common market

- Fault lines in the EU's legal framework.
 - Process of "creating an ever closer union" (art. 1 TEU) is incomplete
 - Completing it requires taking additional "steps", with some being qualitatively significant.
- Example : monetary vs. fiscal policy.
 - The distinction between them is generally well understood.
 - However, some monetary policy decisions can have fiscal implications.
- In the EU Treaties in force, the Union:
 - Has exclusive competence on monetary policy for MS whose currency is the euro.
 - <u>Does not have</u> exclusive competence on fiscal policy.
- There is a reason why:
 - Fiscal policy embodies «sovereignty».



- Fiscal policy embodies «sovereignty»
 - «Right to collect taxes» is i) prerrogative of the sovereign, ii) coercive, iii) central element of all liberal revolutions aiming to restrict its power 1688-89 UK, 1775-89 US, 1789-99 FR
- EU Treaties tread (very) carefully when referring to fiscal policy
 - (there are) Limited inroads regarding Member States' adoption of budgets / fiscal policies
 - Union competencies are explicitly house in the Council: arts. 311, 289 & 126 TFEU
- 5 May 2020 German constitutional court (BVerfGE) sentence
 - Article 38 of the (german) Basic Law Fundamental right to elect representantives.
 - BVerfGE considers EU does not offer the same level of protection.
- 17-21 July 2020 special European Council
 - Recovery and Resilience Facility launched.



The RRF setup and RRPs structure

- Performance-based instrument: Milestones & Targets vs invoices.
- Dedicated to the Green & Digital transitions: 20% & 37% respectively.


Largest EU programme:


- In 2021 total EUR 723bn: EUR 338bn in grants, EUR 385bn in loans.
- In 2023 an additional: EUR 20bn in grants, EUR 2.1bn in BREXIT adjustment reserve.

Deadlines.


- Implementation of reforms and investments: by 31 august 2026.
- Gas infrastructures (within REPowerEU): operational (gas flowing) by 31 December 2026


REPowerEU

- A plan to reduce EU dependence on Russian fossil fuels and accelerate the energy transition
- Based on 3 pillars:
 - Energy saving and energy efficiency
 - Acceleration of investment in renewables
 - Diversification of our energy supplies

Acceleration of investments in RES

New installed capacity in 2022 of renewable energy generation was 58 GW, equivalent to 11.5 bcm of gas:



15 GW for **wind** power generation (+46% from 2021 pace)



41 GW for **solar** power generation (+47% from 2021 pace)




1 GW for **other renewables** power generation

For 2023, industries expect an additional 69 GW of new renewable energy European Commission generation.

Diversification of supply: EU gas imports






Filling Level of EU Gas Storage






Where was Spain ?



New investments

- Financial instruments and subsidy schemes to support the gran transition (e.g. sustainable mobility, energy efficiency, renewable energy), such as the ICO Green Line (EUR 22bn; Regional Resilience Fund (EUR 20bn); subsidy scheme for the circular economy or electric vehicles.
- Additional investments in circulater economy and water management.



New or improved reforms

- Strategy against desertification
- Wate management reform
- Prevention of fodd waste and loss

«Do No significant Harm Principle» (DNSH): No measure harms environmental objectives


REPowerEU chapter

- Reform to improve the framework for granting renewable energy permits.
- Investments in self-consumption, energy storage, energy communities, renewable hydrogen, electricity grid, Renewable energy and industrial decarbonisation value chains (EUR 6.9bn).



- Financial instruments
 - Of the total EUR 83bn in loans, EUR 76bn are, in turn, provided as loans as 14 financial instruments designed to stimulate green, digital and social investments.

Main Financial Instruments (EUR bn)






