   Many pages are updated daily (press releases)




# Europa website – europa.eu

- Different documents: official publications, statistics, surveys, press releases.





# Monetary and financial statistics

- A <u>memorándum of understanding</u> sets out the responsabilities of the ECB and the European Commission (i.e.Eurostat) as regards economic and financial statistics at the European Union level;
- Eurostat has primary responsability for general economic statistics;
- The ECB has primary responsability for monetary and financial statistics, statistics on the international reserves of the Eurosystem, and statistics on the nominal and real effective exchange rates of the euro;
- The two share responsability for balance of payments statistics and financial and non-financial accounts broken down by institutional sector



## Glossary:Gross domestic product (GDP)



(Redirected from Glossary:GDP)

Gross domestic product, abbreviated as GDP, is a basic measure of the overall size of a country's economy.

As an aggregate measure of production, GDP is equal to the sum of the gross value added of all resident institutional units engaged in production, plus any taxes on products and minus any subsidies on products. Gross value added is the difference between output and intermediate consumption.

GDP is also equal to:

- the sum of the final uses of goods and services (all uses except intermediate consumption) measured in purchasers' prices, minus the value of imports of goods and services;
- · the sum of primary incomes distributed by resident producer units.

GDP is one of the main indicators of the European system of national and regional accounts (ESA 2010)

## Glossary:Nomenclature of territorial units for statistics (NUTS)





(Redirected from Glossary:NUTS)

The Nomenclature of territorial units for statistics, abbreviated NUTS (from the French version Nomenclature des Unités territoriales statistiques) is a geographical nomenclature subdividing the economic territory of the European Union (EU) into regions at three different levels & (NUTS 1, 2 and 3 respectively, moving from larger to smaller territorial units). Above NUTS 1, there is the 'national' level of the Member States.


The NUTS is based on Regulation (EC) No 1059/2003 d of the European Parliament and of the Council of 26 May 2003 on the establishment of a common classification of territorial units for statistics (NUTS), which is regularly updated.



#### GDP growth in the euro area and the EU

In the second quarter of 2022, seasonally adjusted GDP increased by 0.8% in the **euro area** and by 0.7% in the EU compared with the previous quarter, according to an estimate published by **Eurostat**, the **statistical office of** the **European Union**. In the first quarter of 2022, GDP had grown by 0.7% in the **euro area** and 0.8% in the **EU**.




Compared with the same quarter of the previous year, seasonally adjusted GDP increased by 4.1% in the **euro area** and by 4.2% in the **EU** in the second quarter of 2022, after +5.4% in the **euro area** and +5.5% in the **EU** in the first quarter of 2022.







## **EUROPEAN CENTRAL BANK**

The main purpose of European Central Bank statistics is to support the monetary policy of the ECB and other tasks of the Eurosystem and the European System of Central Banks.

The statistics are compiled by the ECB with the help of National Central Banks.


National Central Banks collect data from credit institutions and other sources in their respective countries and calculate aggregates at the national level, sending it to the ECB. The ECB calculates the aggregate Euro area

We can obtain data on currency, financial markets, balance of payments, national accounts, labour market, etc.





Monthly exchange rate euro-dólar from 01/01/2018 to 28/09/2018


