Europa Portal – europa.eu

- Europa is the official website of the European Union(EU) . It was created in 1995
- This site allows users :
 - Get information on the EU and what it does , its institutions, policies, the latest events and news
 - Perform certain transactions : apply for job, order and buy documents
 - Give feedback on EU policies , activities and services
- Europa is not a single site , it is an amalgamation of some 150 different sites , each managed independently by the different EU institutions , agencies and bodies plus the individual department (Directorates –General of the Commission)
- How to up-to-date is Europa? Information is revised whenever necessary . Many pages are updated daily (press releases)



Europa Portal – europa.eu

- Europe is a multilingual website (23 official languages of the EU) but not all information is available in all languages
 - Legislation is published in all official languages
 - Specialized information , news and events. Not necessarily in all languages
 - the choice depends on the target audience
- Different formats : pdf, doc, html, excel, videos, photos, podcast
- Different documents : official publications , statistics, surveys, press releases..

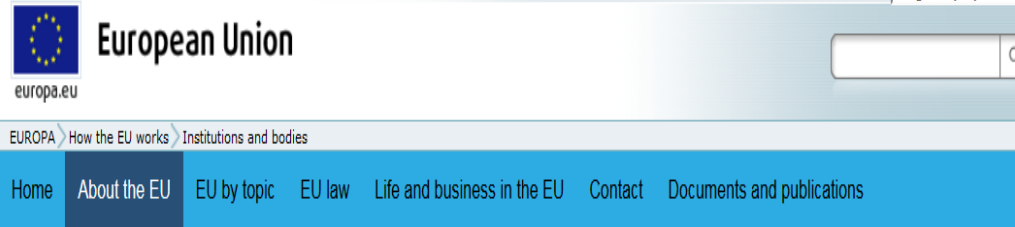

1. Employment

- 75% of the 20-64 year-olds to be employed

2. R&D

- 3% of the EU's GDP to be invested in R&D

3. Climate change and energy sustainability

- **greenhouse gas emissions 20%** (or even **30%**, if the conditions are right) **lower than 1990**
- **20% of energy from renewables**
- **20% increase in energy efficiency**

4. Education

- **Reducing the rates of early school leaving below 10%**
- **at least 40% of 30-34-year-olds completing third level education**

5. Fighting poverty and social exclusion

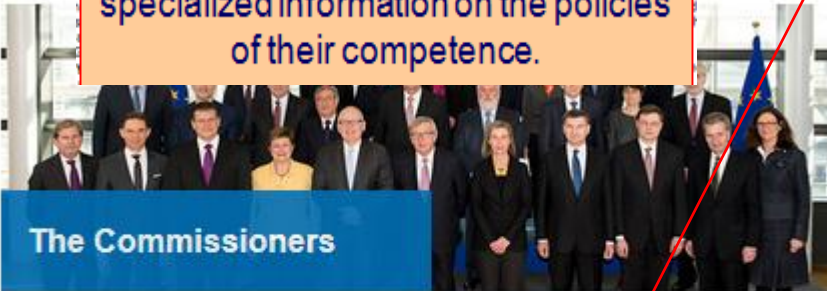





- It is the Statistical Office of the European Union (DG of the European Commission)
It produces harmonized and comparable data across the EU, the EU Member States, the euro area countries, candidate countries, countries of the European Free Trade Association

What does Eurostat?

- Collect data from National Statistical Institutes
- Harmonize data
- Produces European aggregates (EU28 / Eurozone)
- disseminates statistics
- From October 1, 2004 provides direct free access to its databases and electronic publications (PDF) on the Internet.
- Eurostat shares responsibility with the European Central Bank in term of monetary and financial statistics



Economic and financial statistics

A memorandum of understanding sets out the responsibilities of the ECB and the European Commission (i.e. Eurostat) as regards economic and financial statistics at the European Union level:

- › the ECB has primary responsibility for monetary and financial statistics, statistics on the international reserves of the Eurosystem, and statistics on the nominal and real effective exchange rates of the euro;
- › Eurostat has primary responsibility for general economic statistics;
- › the two share responsibility for balance of payments statistics and financial and non-financial accounts broken down by institutional sector.

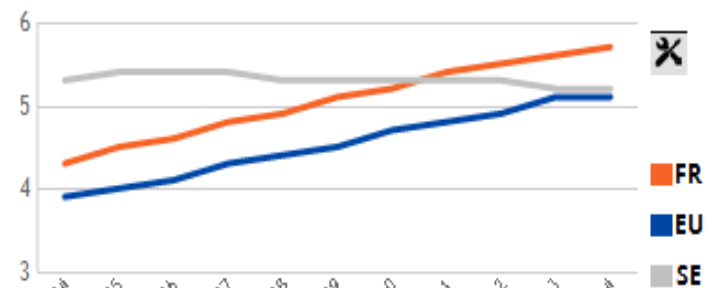

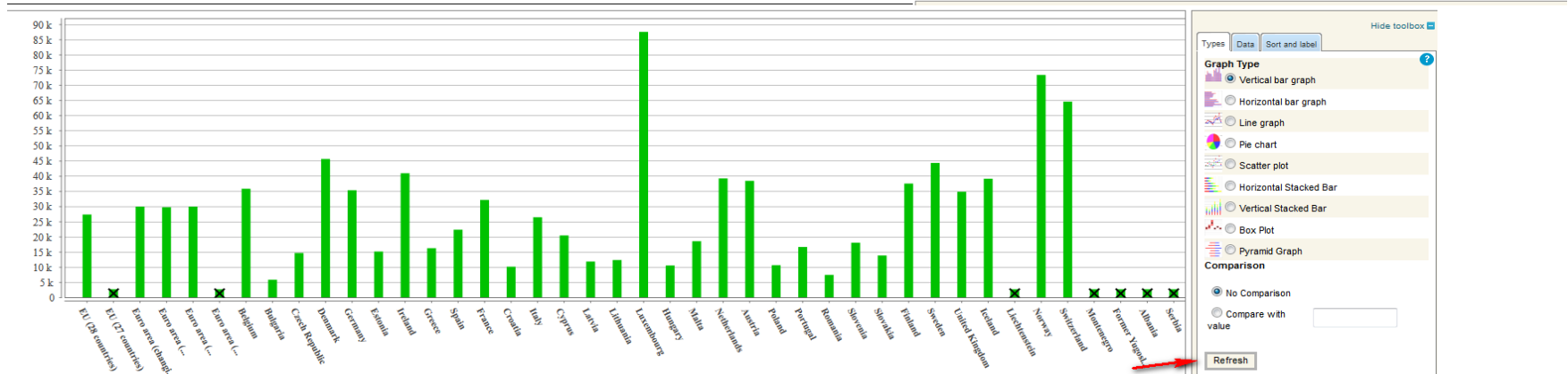

National accounts provide information to analyse the structure of economies and their development over time. The methodology applicable for data transmissions by EU countries from September 2014 onwards is defined by the European System of National and Regional Accounts 2010, ESA 2010. It is consistent with the world wide guidelines (SNA 2008) and replaces the previous system, ESA 95. This ensures the data used to formulate and monitor EU policies is comparable and coherent.

National accounts are the source for a multitude of well-known economic indicators which are presented in this article. Gross domestic product (GDP) is the most frequently used measure for the overall size of an economy, while derived indicators such as GDP per capita — for example, in euro or adjusted for differences in price levels — are widely used for a comparison of living standards, or to monitor the process of convergence across the European Union (EU).

Moreover, the development of specific GDP components and related indicators, such as those for economic output, imports and exports, domestic (private and public) consumption or investments, as well as data on the distribution of income and savings, can give valuable insights into the main drivers of economic activity and thus be the basis for the design, monitoring and evaluation of specific EU policies.

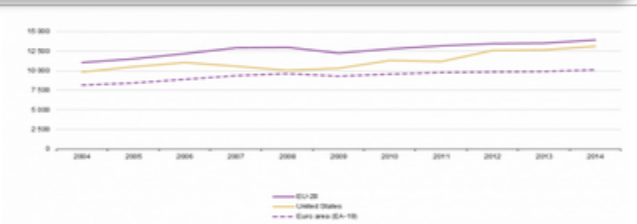


Figure 1: GDP at current market prices, 2004–14 (billion EUR)

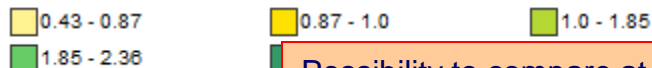

About IFS

The International Financial Statistics (IFS) contains approximately 32,000 time series covering more than 184 countries and areas. It includes all series appearing on the IFS country pages, exchange rates series for all Fund member countries plus Anguilla, Arab, China, P.R., Hong Kong, China, P.R., Macao, Montserrat, and the Netherlands Antilles, major Fund accounts series, real effective exchange rates, and other world, area, and country series from the world tables. Data are available for most IMF member countries with some aggregates calculated for select regions, plus some world totals. Topics covered include balance of payments, banking, banks, commodity prices, exchange rates, exports by commodities, exports by countries, financial statistics, fund accounts, fund credits, government finance, imports by commodities, imports by countries, industrial production, interest rates, international trade, international transactions, investment, labor, monetary authorities, money and banking, national accounts, national income, outstanding obligations to the Fund, population, prices, and real effective exchange rates.
